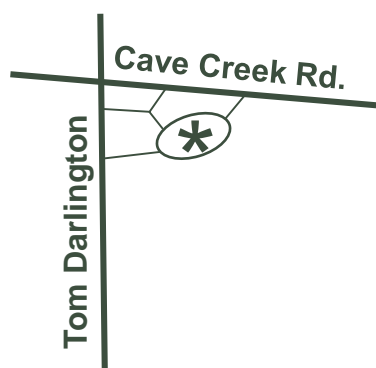
WALKING TOUR MAP
