ITEM #5 Call to the Public:

Public Comment was made by the following:

John Traynor, Carefree, AZ spoke about transparency and trust. He alleged that, based on his readings, information was not accurate in the reports from the Carefree Water Company. He gave his opinion of the development of the NE corner of Carefree Later from the audience, he corrected himself and said he was referring to the property at the NW corner of Carefree Highway and Tom Darlington.

Mike Davitt, Carefree, AZ gave a shout out to the fire fighters and EMTs at Rural Metro and suggested that the Northeast corner of Cave Creek Road and Carefree Highway should have already been developed before implementing a property tax.




Image above depicts Town of Carefree street closure (highlighted in red)

SUMMARY:

During the February, 2023 appointment process for Planning and Zoning Commission/Development Review Board, the Town Council discussed imposing similar terms/term limit to the one enacted on the Town Council by the Carefree electorate. This would entail the staggering of 4-year terms and imposing a term limit of two consecutive four-year terms and a 2-year hiatus period prior to reapplying for consideration on serving on the Commission/Board again.

At the February, 2023 Town Council meeting, 3 incumbents were reappointed, and 4 new Commissioners/Board members were appointed. In accordance with the proposed Ordinance, the 3 incumbents would serve a term of 2 years and can reapply for another 4 years before being termed out. The four new Commissioners/Board members will serve an initial term of 4 years and can reapply for another 4 years before being termed out.

The staggered terms will ensure that every two years, the Town Council may review all applicants interested in serving on the Commission/Board while preserving institutional knowledge through the staggering of the terms.

ACTION NEEDED:

This is the second reading of the proposed Ordinance and public hearing. Once public hearing is conducted/closed on the second reading the Town Council and choose to approve, deny or continue Ordinance #2023-04 which creates term limits for Planning and Zoning Commission/Development Review Board.

TOWN OF CAREFREE, ARIZONA ORDINANCE #2023-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN CAREFREE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III. SECTION 3.02 PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION/DEVELOPMENT REVIEW BOARD ESTABLISHING STAGGER FOUR YEAR TERMS AND A TWO TERM LIMIT

WHEREAS, the electorate in Carefree approved staggered terms with a two contiguous term limit for the Town Council on August 2, 2022.

WHEREAS, in association with the newly seated Council Members, the Council requested a call for applicants interested in serving on the Planning and Zoning Commission/Development Review Board.

WHEREAS, a total of 17 applicants originally applied to be considered which included 6 incumbents and 11 new applicants. One incumbent later withdrew his application, and one incumbent chose not to reapply.

WHEREAS, at the February 7, 2023 Town Council meeting, the Council thanked all the incumbents for their past service and willingness to continue to volunteer and serve their community and thanked all the new applicants for their interest in serving.

WHEREAS, the Council selected 3 incumbents and 4 new applicants to serve on Planning and Zoning Commission/Development Review Board.

WHEREAS, during this appointment process, Councilmembers expressed a desire to continue to integrate new voices into the decision-making process through a similar staggering of terms as Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Mayor and Common Council deem it necessary to amend that certain document know as, "The 2004 Amended Zoning Ordinance for the Town of Carefree".
- Section 2. All Ordinances and portions of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.
- Section 3. The Amendments are made to Article III. Section 3.02, amended as follows (additions are show in double underline, and deleted language is crossed out).

Article III. Section 3.02

Planning and Zoning Commission

PURPOSE

The Planning and Zoning Commission/Development Review Board shall serve as the planning agency for the Town to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance and the Arizona Revised Statutes relating to planning, zoning, subdivision, and building regulations.

ORGANIZATION

The number of members of the Commission/Board shall be seven (7) who shall be appointed by the Town Council to serve without compensation. for a term of office at the pleasure of the Town Council.

Beginning in February, 2023, the Commission/Board terms will consist of four-year staggered terms. At this time (February, 2023) any incumbents which were reappointed in February, 2023 will serve an initial 2-year term. At the expiration of this 2-year term these Commissioners/Boardmembers can serve an additional 4-year term if reappointed by Town Council. After this second term (total of 6 years of service), these Commissioners/Boardmembers must sit out a minimum of 2-years before being considered to serve again. New Commissioners/Boardmembers (nonincumbents) appointed in February 2023 will serve an initial term of 4 years. After initial term they can serve an additional 4-year term if reappointed by Town Council. After this second term (total of 8 years of service), these Commissioners/Boardmembers must sit out a minimum of 2-years before being considered again.


During any term, any vacancy can be filled by appoint of the Town Council to complete the remaining balance of the respective term being filled.

The Commissioners/Boardmembers serve at the pleasure of the Town Council.

The Commission/Boardmembers shall elect one of its members to serve as Chairperson and one to serve as Vice - Chairperson

TOWN OF CAREFREE INFORMATION SUMMARY

MEETING DATE: April 4, 2023

SUBJECT: Public hearing, discussion and possible action regarding proposed modifications to the *Town of Carefree Zoning Ordinance 10th Publication*. The Text Amendment proposes to modify Article II. Rules and Definitions, Section 2.02 Definitions in order to align with and support the recently passed short-term rental regulations in the *Carefree, Arizona Code of Ordinances (Town Code)*. This is a public hearing and comments from the public will be taken.

SUMMARY

On February 7, 2023, Town Council passed new regulations related to short term rentals/vacation rentals. Back in July of 2022, SB 1168 was passed allowing local governments to require short-term rentals to obtain and maintain a local regulatory permit or license, which can only be denied and/or suspended for limited reasons. Provisions relating to neighborhood notification, liability insurance, public health and safety, and sex offender background checks were also included. In essence, these changes now provide tools for local governments to hold "bad actors" accountable for their actions. Ordinance 2022-03 reflects the new authority granted to cities and towns under state law. It aligns with many other community's regulations as well.

In support of 2022-03, language in the Zoning Ordinance needs to be amended in order to clarify occupancy in these rental units. The new text specifies the legal occupancy of a unit, similar to a family; however, it is important to keep in mind that the right for a residential property to operate as a short-term rental use has not been reversed. In essence, the new language tightens and updates definitions that relate to single-family residential uses.

The proposed amendments are attached to this report. At the Planning Commission public hearing, the Commission questioned the origins of the new/revised definitions. Staff

explained this was the language that came out of recent legislation by the State, which as applied allows for regulation of occupancy.

ACTION NEEDED:

An action of approval, denial, or continuance is required at this time.
